This is relevant for any patient that wishes to cancel treatment before they have started stimulation injections or received monitoring (blood tests or scans) by the clinic. This non-refundable deposit is to cover costs incurred by GCRM prior to the patient electing to cancel. These costs include the consent appointment, co-ordination of treatment dates, prescriptions and all administrative processes.

Occasionally treatment cycles have to be cancelled due to a variety of reasons. If this occurs the refund due will be as follows:

Please note:

The regulatory body, the HFEA levies fees on a number of procedures in fertility treatment.

This charge is included in the prices outlined above. The fee charged is shown below:

IVF / ICSI / FET per treatment cycle	£ 75.00
Donor insemination / any treatment cycle involving the use of donor sperm	£ 37.50

Embryos, Sperm and Eggs in storage will incur an annual storage fee. (We will contact you annually to confirm that you wish to continue with storage.)

Independent counselling is provided by GCRM free-of-charge for up to 3 hours of counselling per treatment cycle. It is available during and for up to three months after treatment has finished.

In the event of an unexpected interruption to our services which is out with our control, your treatment may have to be cancelled. In this case you will be entitled to a full refund.
